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



SEND CONTRIBUTION WITH ORIGINAL RETURN WHEN MAILING. Do not send coin, currency or stamps. Send check, Cashier's Check or Money Order payable to the CALIFORNIA UNEMPLOYMENT RESERVES COMMISSION for the full amount of the contribution.

CONTRIBUTION IS DUE AND PAYABLE ON JULY 1, 1937, AND DELINQUENT AUGUST 1, 1937. If remittance is not postmarked on or before midnight of July 31, 1937, interest charges of 12 per cent per annum must be assessed under the law. The Act contains no provision for waiver of interest.
