## CONTRIBUTION REPORT FOR JULY, 1937

Contribution is due and payable on August 1, 1937, and delinquent September 1, 1937. If remittance is not postmarked on or before midnight of August 31, 1937, interest charges of 12 per cent per annum must be assessed under the law. The Act contains no provision for waiver of interest.
