are bringing things for demonstration, etc.

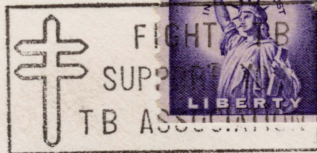
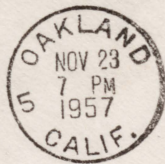
I do not like to seem impatient, but
