These are authentic Japanese kiriwood hibachi. In Japan the hibachi is used as a charcoal-burning hand warming unit which may be carried about in the house. The illustration shows several suggested adaptations for western use: as a planter, as a cigarette snuffer and as a "candle-planter." Being hollow, even the large size hibachi is quite light. A removable copper pan of adequate depth fits snugly at the top. Beautifully grained kiriwood is native to Japan and is available only there.

The parasol lantern, of white paper on bamboo framing, slips over any standard drop light fixture and holds its position through an ingenious spring tension design. Installed or removed in a moment the lantern may be collapsed into a roll for storage or shipping (see picture No. 3 for collapsed roll). When lighted the lantern gives a soft, diffused glow to the pleasing parallelogram shape.

The parasol lantern is shown collapsed on the display board with the wooden ring base and screw-in tripod legs.
