

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

NOBU ARAI

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, NOBU ARAI, of Seattle, Washington, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and of legal age, and not acting under duress, menace, fraud or the undue influence of any person whomsoever, but considering the uncertainty of life, do make, publish and declare this to be my ~~last~~ will and testament, hereby revoking and annulling all wills and codicils heretofore by me made.

I.

I hereby direct that there shall be paid from my estate the expenses of my last illness, and all just debts, if any, that may be unpaid at my death; except, however, those obligations, if any, which may be a specific lien or charge upon property in which I may be interested, which obligations and charges my Executor is authorized to continue in force for such time as in his judgment may be deemed necessary or advantageous to my estate.

II.

I hereby declare that I am widowed and that my four children are:

Donald N. Arai

Gerald Y. Arai

David Y. Arai

Joanne M. Mar (Mrs. Raymond Mar)

all of whom are adults.

III.

I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of my estate, real, personal or mixed, of every type and nature and wheresoever situate

of which I may die seized or possessed, to my children above named, share and share alike, or if any of my four children shall fail to survive me and shall have children, to such grandchildren of mine by right of representation; otherwise, the share of any deceased child shall be divided equally among the others.

IV.

I hereby nominate and appoint my eldest son, DONALD N. ARAI, as Executor of this, my last will and testament, and it is my will and I hereby direct that said Executor shall serve without bond. In the event that my eldest son, DONALD N. ARAI, is for any reason unable or unwilling to act as Executor hereof, I nominate and appoint my sons GERALD Y. ARAI and DAVID Y. ARAI as alternate Executors, in that order, also to act without bond.

V.

I further direct that my estate be settled without the intervention of any court, except to the extent required by law, and that my Executor settle my estate in such manner as shall seem best and most convenient to him, and I hereby empower my Executor to mortgage, sell, lease, exchange and convey the personal and real property of my estate without an order of court for that purpose and without notice, approval or confirmation, and in all other respects to administer and settle my estate without the intervention of court as is provided by the statutes of the State of Washington.
