Dear Mr. Arai:


We have your letter of January 8, 1946 regarding your property in the WRA warehouse in Seattle.

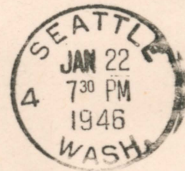
