Just thought I'd drop you a line. My post office address has finally changed. I am now located in Milwaukee, Wis. I arrived here on May 25 at noon. At the present time I am not working. For short I am looking for work. Work is plentiful here but I'm kind of choosy. Hi!

Milwaukee is a swell place (even though I was a devout Madisonian a short time ago). This city reminds me of San Francisco. Yes, it brings back fond memories of the past. Somehow I still like Madison a little better.

I guess school will be over for you soon. What are your plans? Are you going to work or attend summer school or are you coming out this way? No kidding, it's rather nice on this side of the Mississippi River.

From what I hear there are about 200 evacuees here. So far, I have met about a dozen ~~about~~ them. The kids here are supposed to be pretty good joes.

Mickey wrote to me once, but I haven't written back yet. I guess I'll write to her soon.

I'm planning to visit Madison this weekend. I'd like to renew acquaintances with some of the joes I knew before I left that city. By joes I mean men! Fooled you, didn't I?

There's going to be a picnic and a dance for the evacuees this month. If I'm still around, I may drop in to see what's doing. I'll just look over the sights and forget about wolfing. Anyway I don't like to wolf around anyway.

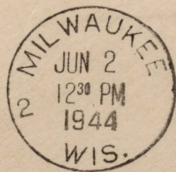
