Dear Kimi,

Thank you for your very kind note. I have spent so many hours at the hospital these last 5 weeks I have been especially grateful to the people who have not phoned, since there has been almost nothing to say and I have been exhausted.

Arnold came home last Thursday, Oct 10, and we were both delighted that he was here although he was as weak as a baby. Then on Sunday he suffered another embolism and had to be rushed back to the hospital. The danger now is that new embolisms will force the doctor to give him anti-coagulants again, which affect the surgical healing practically. But, although he is frighteningly weak, he is being watched very carefully and being given marvellous care. It was just a bitter disappointment. The doctor will not release him for at least 10 more days this time, to be more realistic about his condition.

It is the best help I can have to know that good friends love us and care so much. Thank you again for telling me so.
