



Moscone Hails Voter Signup Plan

State Senator George R. Moscone, who is running for mayor of San Francisco in the November elections, yesterday endorsed a plan for voter registration to be greatly expanded throughout the city.

"If government wants more citizen input and caring," the Democrat in the nonpartisan race said, "then government must assist the process whereby people enter into the political system."

Moscone has introduced a bill in the Senate to simplify registration procedures under California law and permit voters to register through the eve of election day.

Moscone's endorsement was in a statement distributed at a press conference called by Citizens for Representative Government, an organization of community
