Dear Kimi,

Here, at long last, is your oral history memoir. It had to go through the print shop twice because the first job was unacceptable. But finally it is done and I am pleased to be able to send it on to you.

When you have the time will you look it over and let me know if there are any serious errors of fact in it. I think we have it all correct but sometimes a typo will make a major change, or sometimes, despite the care in editing and review and proofreading an error will be found. If you find a simple typo, like first spelled firts, we know that the reader will be able to figure out the word and we will not make any revisions. (except in the ribbon copy if you call the error to my attention). We will, however, make corrections in the other manuscripts already bound, which are serious. If I do not hear from you by April 15, I'll assume all is well and we can notify research libraries that your memoir is available for deposit.

These oral histories are made for research and go into libraries which purchase them for deposit. Family members are the only individuals who may have the volumes--except for rare occasions-- and the cost of a volume is \$24.00. Checks, made out to the Friends of the Bancroft Library, earmarked for the Kimi Fujii Kitayama oral history, and mailed to this office, will make it possible for family members to own their own copies.

I hope that you will be pleased with the results. I would be interested to know how you are and if the nursery is now operating again and that all goes well with the Kitayamas.
