The recent major cutbacks in federal funds, coming as they did at a time when so many people were turning to the government for opportunity, presented Hayward Mayor Leo Howell with one of the greatest challenges of his office. Large numbers of the area's re-

cently returned veterans, young people, and the disadvantaged now faced the bleak prospects of unemployment and, seemingly, no new job market to which they could turn.

But the Mayor knew there had to be jobs in this area of so many

industries, and he contacted the National Alliance of Businessmen to help him find them. Aided by this powerful group, Mayor Howell began to organize a task force to locate the "job well," and one of the first calls for volunteers went to Shaklee Corporation.

Mayor's Task Force obtained over 1,800 jobs for Veteran's & Youth.
