Dear Kimi:

Thank you for accepting appointment as the George W. Phillips Hayward Campaign Chairman! Now, we'll have to get down to work and elect George on November 6th.

As we have previously discussed, your job is to organize Hayward, along with your co-chairman, Marsh Hanson, so that it returns a resounding majority for George. As we explained, we have organized the County into two sections, North and South. The Campaign Assistant for South County is Sue Clemens. As the campaign progresses, Sue will be in touch with you to assist in any problems which you might have. Any time you get into difficulty, you can either call Sue or myself at campaign headquarters.

Now, specifically, what do we want you to do? In Hayward, we want you to organize the following committees: finance, precincts, lawyers, doctors, business, real estate, teachers, labor and women's groups. In addition, as we discussed, you should organize any other committees you think proper, such as Portuguese Americans for George or Japanese Americans for George or Veterans for George.

Enclosed herewith you will find a program for each of these committees. The general letter applies to every committee other than finance and precincts. For finance and precincts, we have specific letters and instructions. Once, all the committee chairmen have been picked by you, would you please notify us so that we might set up a meeting at which the committee chairmen can meet George and we can kick off the campaign for your area.

We have received the precinct maps and are in the process of putting the votes for George on the map for Hayward. In addition, we are relating all of our workers to the precincts in which they live. When this is complete, we will provide you with a list of all workers that we have for Hayward, together with the precincts in which they live. This should be most helpful to you and your precinct chairman in obtaining precinct workers.

We are also in the process of preparing a detailed biography on George, so that your workers will have background information to use in answering questions concerning his candidacy.


