Dear Mrs. Fujii:

It is with pleasure that I have appointed you a member of the Board of Directors of the 1st District Agricultural Association. As you know, this board is the governing body of the association whose principal function is the holding of an annual Fair to exhibit the products of the district.

District agricultural associations are branches of the State Government which operate under State laws and regulations and receive a portion of their financing from the State treasury. Your Secretary-Manager will furnish you with a booklet describing these laws and regulations and outlining your duties and responsibilities. The Department of Finance through its Fairs and Expositions Division assists the district and county fairs with their business and budgetary matters. The 1959 session of the Legislature amended the law to require much more strict budgetary review in respect to State funds allocated to these Fairs. I am asking all directors of district fairs to take a new look at each fair with the objective of increasing its benefits to the district it serves, both in the improved quality of its annual Fair and in the better utilization of its fairgrounds and facilities throughout the year. I am asking also that careful attention be given to its business affairs to the end that the greatest possible value be derived from the monies received and spent by the district.

Your commission and oath of office are enclosed, together with a memorandum of what is necessary to qualify under this commission.

I appreciate very much your willingness to perform this public service, and I will look forward to seeing you.
