- 3. One(1) Victory Bond (\$250.00) held by the aforesaid bank as a collateral security for J. S. Miwa & Co., Ltd., of Honolulu, T. H.
- 4. Petty cash on deposit with the Bishop National Bank of Hawaii at Honolulu.
