

SUM-UP OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA MEETINGS

December 11, 1977

On December 11, in Los Angeles, California State University of Los Angeles called together Asian Student organizations and individuals to discuss the work of Asian students in fighting the Bakke Decision and to discuss the establishment of a communication network of the organization. This meeting grew out of the sentiment to continue and develop the movement of Asian organizations supporting each other and working together on joint activities (i.e., Santa Barbara Conference, Tule Lake Pilgrimage, etc.)

Out of this statewide meeting, resolutions supporting the anti-Bakke struggle through the ABDC (Anti-Bakke Decision Coalition), as well as the individual struggles on various campuses, and calling for a statewide conference on Feb. 18 weekend were passed. To help build for that conference, Northern and Southern California Regionals were set up to do outreach and help get feedback for the planning of the conference.

January 14, 1978

A Northern California Regional Asian Student Organization meeting was held at UC Berkeley. Here we discussed the resolutions that came out of the December 11th meeting and set up a communication network for the Northern California Region. Eleven campuses were in attendance and each gave a brief talk on the state of their organization and some of their current and future activities. We also chose Conference Coordinating Representatives (CC reps) to plan the statewide conference. Future joint activities we discussed were a Tule Lake Pilgrimage, fundraisers for the West Coast Conference, and mobilization for future Anti-Bakke activities.

January 21, 1978

The Northern California cc reps met in San Francisco to tie up loose ends from the January 14th meeting and prepare an agenda for the next Northern California Regional meeting in Stanford.

January 29, 1978

The Northern California CC reps met in Berkeley with the CC reps from Southern California to plan for the West Coast Conference.

February 4, 1978

A second Northern California Regional meeting was held at Stanford University. We formally presented the communication network and discussed the roles of the CC reps. The Tule Lake Pilgrimage was proposed and a planning committee will be formed at a later date. The Anti-Bakke Decision Coalition (ABDC) made a presentation giving an update on ABDC activities and discussed Asian Student Organization's role in the movement. Next we discussed the upcoming West Coast Conference. The CC reps recieved helpful feedback from the body to help finalize the program planning.

February 11, 1978

The CC reps met in Santa Barabra to finish the planning of the West Coast Conference.

March 5, 1978

The third Northern California Regional Asian Student Organization meeting will be held at UC Davis. Here we will report on the West Coast Conference and the National Anti-Bakke conference and plan future Northern California Regional activities, including Tule Lake..
