PROPOSITION 63—THE ENGLISH-ONLY INITIATIVE

Unnecessary, Divisive and Dangerous!

Proposition 63, entitled "English as the Official Language of California," is one of the most misleading and potentially harmful ballot measures Californians have voted on in years.

What is Proposition 63?

Proposition 63 is a constitutional amendment which requires the California legislature to enact laws to "preserve and enhance the role of English." It prohibits the government from taking any action which "diminishes or ignores the role of English." It also gives anyone the right to sue if they think this vague law is not enforced.

What does Proposition 63 do?

Proposition 63 is so vague and so far-reaching that it could result in:

- The elimination of interpreters for police, fire, and emergency services, including 911 telephone operators.
- The elimination of vital public service information, such as pamphlets informing non-English speaking parents how to enroll their children in public schools.
- The elimination of interpreters at public hospitals and translated medical admission forms for non-English speaking patients.
- The elimination of driver's license tests and Department of Motor Vehicles forms in other languages.
- The elimination of bilingual programs at public schools to help non-English speaking students learn English.
- The filing of numerous lawsuits to ban the use of other languages everywhere, including advertising by private businesses.

Proponents of Proposition 63 are trying to campaign on the premise that their constitutional amendment is a simple symbolic declaration that English is our official language. But, their ballot measure goes far beyond symbolism. Proposition 63 breeds intolerance and bigotry. It will discourage the assimilation of new citizens into American society. It will deny essential services to people in need. Proposition 63 is misleading, dangerous and unfair.

Proposition 63 is a divisive law Californians do not need.
