▶ **W**hat Can We Do?

This is a pivotal year for education in California. This Spring, the State Legislature will be deciding on the Master Plan for Higher Education, which will set higher educational policy in the state for the next 25 years. The state legislature will also be deciding on crucial issues of funding for our public schools.

Our voices must be heard in Sacramento this Spring!

And they can be. We are working with sympathetic legislators to write our concerns into legislation. On April 10 we March on Sacramento to insure that our vision for a fair and quality education becomes state law.

▶ **H**ow is California Educating our Youth?

- *California has an economy larger than all but five nations in the entire world, yet our public schools are overcrowded, underfunded and understaffed.*
- *California has the second most overcrowded classrooms of any state in the nation and the second worst pupil/teacher ratio. California ranks 46th in Education spending compared to income.*
- *50% of African American, Chicano/Latino, American Indian, Pilipino and South East Asian youth drop out of high school before graduation.*
- *Out of every thousand students of color enrolled in a California Community College this year, only 4 will transfer to a UC and 22 to a CSU.*
- *Racism on college campuses is on the rise.*
- *Less than 40% of Chicano/Latino and African American students entering UC's and CSU's will graduate.*
