We have been informed by the Communications Center that the hosting city (that's us!) will need to arrange housing accommodations for approximately 1,000 people who will be driving in late Sunday evening.

We need to seek out, ideally, large facilities that can house groups of people (bus loads). We would also like to have these locations as near as possible to the starting point for the day - Southside Park at 7th and T Streets. We will need floor space for sleeping; restrooms; shower facilities, if possible; parking.

The following is a basic list of questions:

1. Can they accommodate groups of people for this?
2. Is Sunday evening available?
3. How many people can they hold?
4. Description of facilities: bathrooms (#), etc.
5. Charges? Pay by when? Deposit required? Non-refundable?
6. Special restrictions and/or instructions?

Since the day is very near, we should tentatively reserve what is available NOW, and we will figure out the costs/payment soon thereafter.

I have attached a copy of what was done two years ago, for your information. It may also trigger other ideas you may have.
