The following named civilian employees assigned to the U.S. Strategic Bombing Survey, (Pacific), and on duty in Japan pursuant to temporary duty letter orders issued by The Adjutant General, Washington, D.C. are directed to proceed on or about 1 December 1945 from Tokyo, Japan, to San Francisco, California, and to places of engagement shown in original travel orders, as listed.

2. Travel by surface vessel to San Francisco is directed. Travel by rail within the United States auth. TDN chargeable to 601-1 P 432-02 A 212-60425 S99-999. In lieu of subsistence, a flat per diem of \$6.00 while within and \$7.00 while outside the continental limits of the U.S. is authorized while traveling and while on temporary duty and while absent from permanent station. No per diem is authorized for travel on beard ships where the cost of passage includes meals.

3. Certificates of identification, WD AGO Forms 6508, and other papers intended as War Department credentials for overseas will be surrendered at the Port of Embarkation, Ft Mason, California.

4. Civilians will comply with applicable U.S. and War Department regulations in clearing all obligations, turning in items of government equipment, exchange of currency, and removal of trophies, prior to departure.
