Hello "Pop." How are you and every body back home? Especially my friends in "Water-Department". We are doing okay. "Pop" good but I'm very very homesick - and missing lots of good friend back home. - Everyday we are hoping to return home soon. After staying in Pinedale W. C. C. F. for couple of month we came to Tule Lake W. R. F. near Oregon border about 30 miles from Klammas Fall Oregon.

This place is about about 4,000' above sea level and there are about 15,000 Japanese here. I am working as a 50th District Block Manager - wage \$19⁰⁰ per month.

Mr Gasney it's the best wage in this camp. I got a secretary (she is pretty one too) and a office.

In Pinedale I had a job as a super-
visor of mess hall. I had 55 boys
& girls worked for me, we fed 500 people
3 times a day. You see I named my
mess hall "Roy's Place" Pinedale's
Best Food Joint. After we left there
I packed the sign & send it to Roy
& Edward in Auburn. Next time you
drop in there please look at it.

Will Mr. Goney. I haven't much
to say but please take good care
of yourself and give my regards to
all the people in City Hall. Mr.
Brew and his partner, your partner.
Mr. Ludwick and other fella and
Fire Dept fella.
