Such conditions or restrictions include the special conditions stated on the reverse side hereof and the conditions that this leave shall not permit entry into a prohibited or restricted area unless the person to whom it is issued obtains a military pass or other authorization before he enters such an area, if it is required by the military authorities, and observes the restrictions applicable to such area; that the holder of this leave will notify the Regional Director of any change for any reason in his employer or in his address; and that this leave shall not permit the holder to be any place except at or en route to or from the destination stated above.

1. Each student, after he is officially enrolled in the college or university to which this leave applies, shall be privileged to represent such college or university in any of its athletic or scholastic activities and shall be privileged to travel away from such educational center in company with other students, coaches or sponsors of such college activities in the same manner and to the same extent as would any regularly enrolled student except that this authorization shall not apply to the travel within Military Area No. 1 or the California portion of Military Area No. 2 unless and until written authorization for such release or travel has been given by Authority of the Commanding General, Western Defense Command and Fourth Army, by permits issued by or under authority of the Civil Affairs Division.
