COUNT I.

That K. YAMADA, whose true and full name is to the grand jurors unknown, on or about the seventh day of June, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-seven, at those certain premises known as 114 First Avenue, in the City of Seattle, in the Northern Division of the Western District of Washington, and within the jurisdiction of this court then and there being, did then and there knowingly, wilfully and unlawfully sell, give away, dispose of, exchange and barter certain malt, spiritous and intoxicating liquor, to-wit:

FIVE (5) PINTS OF BEER

a more particular description of the amount and kind whereof being to the grand jurors unknown, to Joe Redhorn and Stella Redhorn, the said Joe Redhorn and Stella Redhorn being then and there Indians, wards

of the government of the United States of America under charge of an Indian Superintendent and Indian Agent, and Indians over whom the Government of the United States of America, through its departments, exercises guardianship; contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.
