

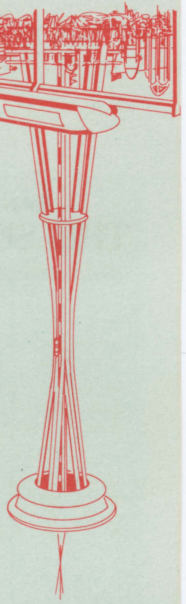

Will feature a trip through outer space plus other elaborate scientific displays. This pavilion is a six unit complex.

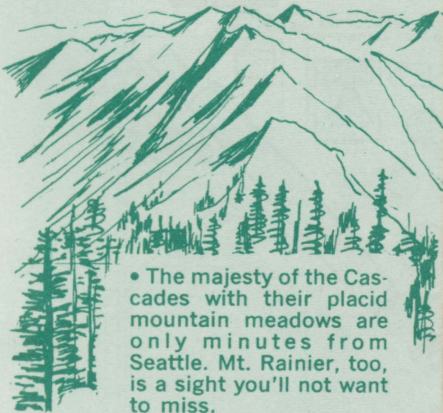

- The majesty of the Cascades with their placid mountain meadows are only minutes from Seattle. Mt. Rainier, too, is a sight you'll not want to miss.

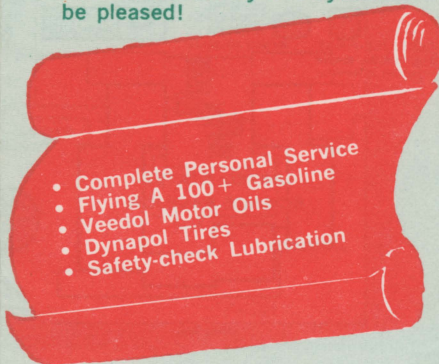
- For the fresh or salt water fisherman, charter boats for salmon are available at Westport and Olympic National Park offers its streams for mountain trout.
