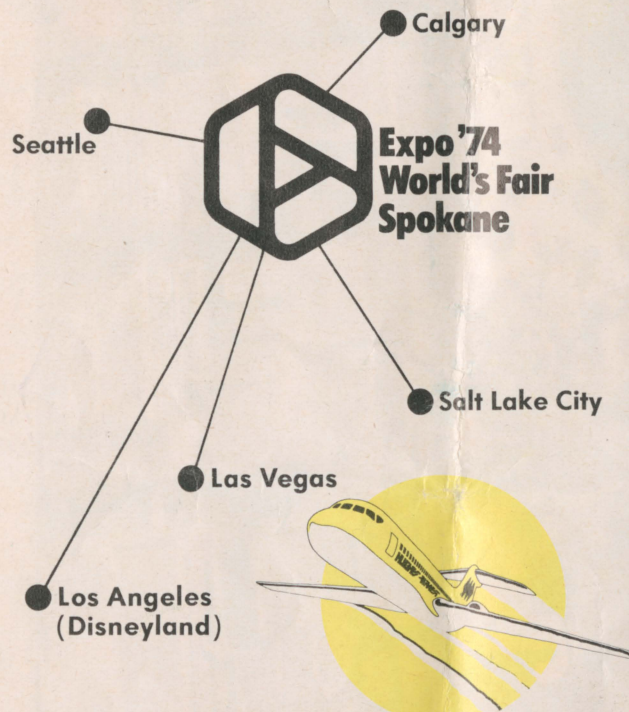

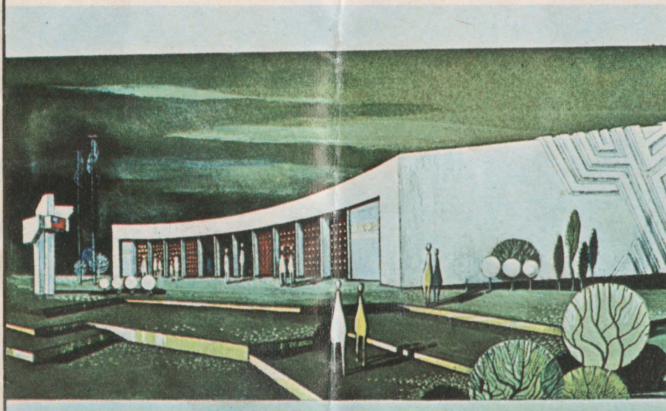

From Taipei, provisional capital of the Republic of China, comes this message:

NO VISIT TO EXPO '74 IS COMPLETE WITHOUT A VISIT TO THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA PAVILION



There you will see reflected 5,000 years of Chinese history and its projection to the present-day Republic of China founded by Dr. Sun Yat-sen on New Year's Day 1912.

Taipei is the nerve center of foreign trade which reached US\$8.2 billion in 1973, making the Republic of China one of the world's top trading nations and No. 1 among developing countries. This trade is expected to exceed US\$10 billion in the current year.

The Republic of China has reason to be proud of this achievement. But it is even prouder of the role assigned to it by history of being the custodian and preserver of the glorious cultural heritage of Cathay, notably the code of ethics propounded by the illustrious sage Confucius (551-479 B.C.)

The theme of the Republic of China's Pavilion is "Ethics, Democracy, Science."

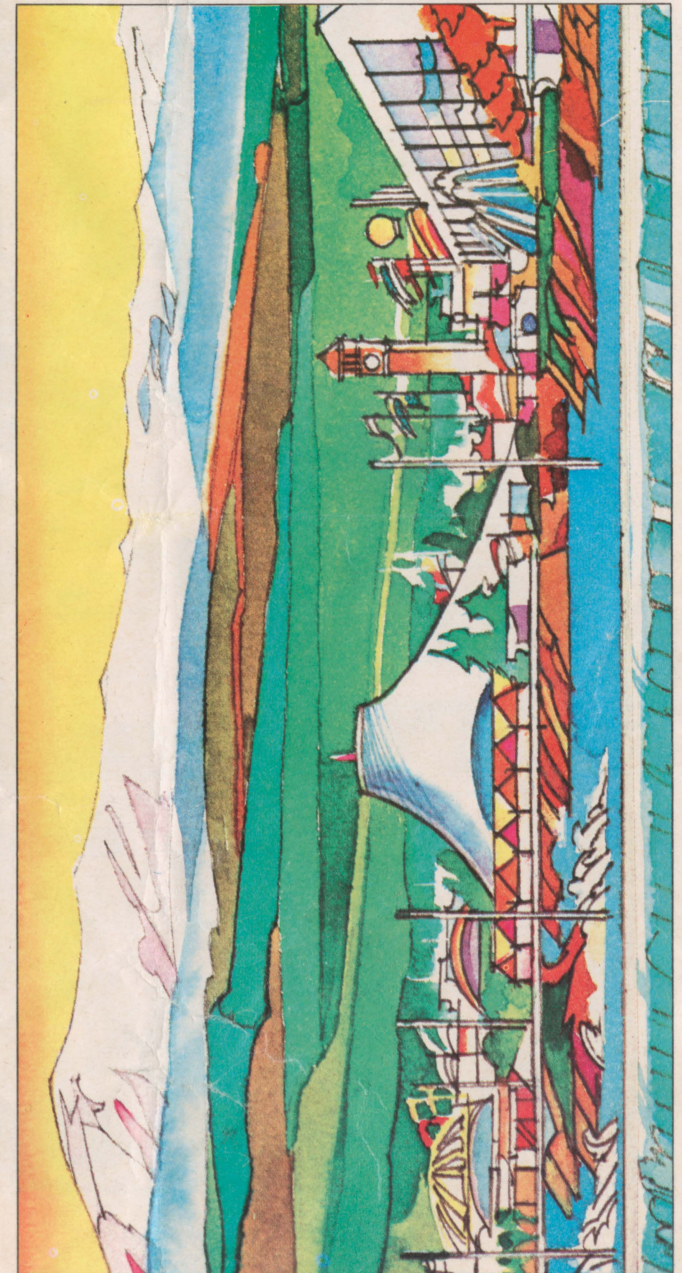
This is vividly depicted in an 18-minute computer-operated film projected on a giant screen in a 236-seat theater. The showings are continuous.
