## CENTER CLOSURE

The Minidoka Relocation center will go out of existence November 1st of this year. There are still approximately 4500 evacuees left in the center.

According to W.R.A. the local center is leading all the centers in the merry race of liquidation. Thirty and one tenth per cent of the center have relocated since January 2nd, or 2,376 persons. The Granada center in Colorado follows with 23.5 per cent since the beginning of the year.

It looks as if the Church will go out of existence with practically every family on the verge of relocation or with definite plans in the near future. However, its ministry will be continued until the last with a modified program to meet community needs.
