Dear Mrs. Nishimura:

Your kind letter which came in January was appreciated greatly. However, it was not possible to answer it at that time.

I still feel that it is exceedingly difficult for me to express to you what faith Tomio had in our services. Such a faith brings great responsibility and if one can measure up to it, then we feel that we have accomplished a great deal. I regret that I was not able to talk to your husband and tell him how Tomio never held any resentment toward our government for having developed tuberculosis or having lost anything because of the war conditions. He told me that he was only glad that he had the privilege of living in America. You may know that he made two beautiful ship models which I will always treasure. Both are the work of an artist and the only hard thing is that I have to be reminded of not having been able to save him.

To you goes my appreciation for your very kind letter.
