

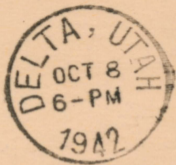
Dear Dr. Inglis, Oct 8, 1942

Just a note to tell you
that I'm here and helping
along with the ch. work. For
a week I was helping with
housing taking care of the
complaints & adjustments.
The work was too demanding in
causing a nervous exhaustion.
I took a week to recuperate.
Just feeling like myself now.

Dr. Chapman & his brother
were here yesterday. The
interview clarified our position
as ministers in the WRA
center. We hope to have 2
5000 bldg. for a center with
10,000 people. Ministers car
be paid \$19.00 or \$16.00 in
any kind of work here outside
of religious activities. I am
planning to do just what
I am trained for.
