Dear Mr. Peckham

Almost all my implement which I sent back from Gridley and some I left at home, they should be in my new shed, but some one reported to me that nothing is left in my shed so I think the Seed Co., or someone else is using my implements around there. I expect Mr. Scott to know where they are so I wish you to talk to Mr. Scott about the implements for Mr. Monahan and before he start to work. My house hold goods which are in the house where I was living and some in the tank house (bottom ^{and} top) Mr. Scott is taking care of the keys for both house. I have put a list of all the things in this envelope and I also sent a copy each of the list to Mr. Monahan and Mr. Scott so when ~~Mr. Monahan~~ Mr. Monahan visit your office I wish you will talk well to Mr. Monahan about his wages and his truck expense. Any amount he offers will be satisfactory. I wrote to Mr. Monahan about loading the cars just for personal information, but I wish you will talk well to Mr. Monahan about the best time to order the cars, and some other things I order to Mr. Monahan. I wrote this list just for your memory so in case Mr. Monahan calls you up after he starts, please give him the best advice.

I think we need two cars, one box and one flat car. We need the flat car ordered and delivered along side of Mr. Winsor Warehouse. I wrote to Mr. Winsor to help us by examining the implement and if some need repairing them or to take some apart and when it is loading time to help with his power hoist to load the implements on the flat car. In the meantime I ordered one of his special tractor floats and planters, Celery hiller.

I tried to get permit for them, but they said they can only give one for this county, but I need the float badly so I wish you to get the permit some way. But in case it is hard to get a permit for planted Jr. Celery ~~hiller~~ hiller leave for some other time.

I wish you would call Mr. Winsor to send the bills to your office and please pay the bill for all expense from ^{my} account.

I wish to have the box car delivered in front of the Milpitas Depot. There is a platform which the Ford car or tractor can be driven up on to load.

I wrote to Mr. Monahan that if he needs lumber and nails to go and get them from Milpitas Lumber Co. I think Mr. Crab of the Lumber Company will call you up and talk about payment. So I wish you will guarantee to payment the bill from my account.

about the Ford car like I explained in the
last I wrote to the Krusich Garage to look
over the car before Mr. Monahan load it so the
garage will call you so I wish you will pay
the garage man. The car engine and tire were in
good condition when we left it.

~~When everything is finished loading please
send a telegram to us, but in case we have moved
we will send our address by telegram to you.
At last I wish you will send a list of all the
expenses to us please.~~

Anyhow Mr. Monahan after he almost
complete collecting my implements, Mr. Union
Rye Tractor Co. and Krusich Garage finish what
I wish to have done. Then Mr. Monahan can start
loading the box ~~and~~ flat cars anytime, I wish before
you order the cars to please let me know by telegram.
At that time I think ^{the} title of the abstract will be clearer
than it is now.

Like I wrote in the other letter the ranch has
a house, but someone is living in it now. As
soon as the deed is completed we want to move
the person who is living there before we move
in.

If it is ~~possible~~ possible we wish to move in
before the implements come.

List of house hold goods

We left some things in my home, some which are ours and some belong to the boys, but I wish to put ~~most~~ ^{most} of them in the box car, ~~except~~ the following things.

We do not need - davenport, tables, chairs, desks, bookcases, books, gas stove, beds, springs, mattresses, all other big furnitures,

We need all the trunks, ~~wooden boxes~~, cardboard boxes, or in cloth sacks all ^{things in} my closet things 2 overcoats and all paper boxes ^{and other} things, one Singer sewing machine, one washing machine

If I have any more room in the car I wish to have everything in the tent house top and bottom most, ^{then} I put in the paper boxes or wood boxes and wrapped with paper, things which I put numbers on, I ordered Mr. Monahan first thing to do for us something for one person who worked at our place. He wishes to have these things sent by collect express. The following things from my house - one very new Singer sewing machine, one Vanity table, and one Refrigerator is Storage Co. I told Mr. Monahan to order some where a storage house Co. let them come and get the things to pack up and let them send ^{them} by collect express under the following name and address. R. Matsui R #1 Grand Junction Colorado. So I wish if the Storage Co. sends you a statement to pay from my account, please do it and send to us express receipt and storage house paid receipt please.

At least if it needs painting have it painted because we have to leave it outside.

If possible I wish to have the D2 repaired or overhauled under the Seed Company's name.

The time recorder read 2640^{hrs} when we sent the D2 back from Gridly, Calif.

I wish to have D2 left in the shop until loading begins then have the D2 loaded directly on the car.

Track roller grease pump. High pressure grease gun. Transmission grease gun.

One 2 qt oil measure cup ^(copper coated) penetrating oil cup (copper coated) spring operated oil cup

all the wrenches which are included with D2, D9 power take off pulley, endless red belt.

Farmall F12 four wheels.

One single rubber tire including rims and frame for front.

One draw bar, One complete 3 row lister attachment including 3 large ditcher stands

One bar fit on the draw bar to pull 3 working cultivators.

One grease gun handle is little broken, one wrench for wheel adjustment.

Low crop Bean spray rig. We changed the engine to a 8 horse power new engine before evacuation, never used yet.

One 12 nozzles, 4 row outfit stand One two row special made 6 nozzle hand spray gun.

3 single nozzle spray guns. Two pieces. two hundred and fifty feet ^{long} spray hoses.

One Ring roller (mash harrows) We have a contract between the seed company and us saying that the seed company can use our ring roller but Mr. Scott very kindly let us use it at Gridley Calif. so please talk to Mr. Scott to let us use it again.

One Wooden roller (special made single horse roller)

One John Deere two wheel riding Cultivator including 10 stands, clamps, & a pair of discs

One Planted Junior two wheel riding Cultivator including 10 stands, clamps, and a pair of discs

One John Deere four wheel top bed Cultivator including all kinds of stands & clamps

One John Deere 3 wheel beets Cultivator including stands and clamps.

One 550 gal diesel fuel tank complete with pump and rubber hose, redwood blocks - for foundations

One Planted Junior one bed seed planter (made by Mr. Winsor)

300 gal Wooden water supply tank including two sets of pipe and faucets

2 pieces of 1 1/4 inch rubber hose about 25 ft. long.

One John Deere hammer machine all complete

One Japanese scraper including a 2 wheel trailer to ride on

One team horse spring harrow

Two Crab harrows made by Winsor One is all steel made and the other has a wooden frame.

2 pumping system are shoulders type dusters.

400 pieces of 1 1/4 inch irrigation steel pipes we have a total of around 2000 pieces of pipes so the balance of the 400 leave them there.

10 pieces about 40 inches width main ditch water shutters.

Small ditch water shutters we made over 900 pieces but I am letting Mr. Scott use 200 pieces so we wish to have the rest. They are 25¢ each and we can't get any now so I wish to have them.

all kinds of double, single and some other kinds of trees

all kinds of poles long & short, in new shed or in Ford truck garage.

One wooden wheelbarrow, One all-steel wheelbarrow
One all-steel pickup truck bed (Ford), extra team horse and single horse lines,
Manila hemp ropes have been used for hoist, One ton and a half ($1\frac{1}{2}$ ton) karst. (chain)
4 steel bars, 4 pieces medium size chains, Woodenderrick

Almost all the things in the new shed storage rooms (Top & bottom.)

all small parts (implements) cultivator ditchers, & knives, tethers, plow shears,
old hoes, shovels, forks, posthold digger, chain wrench ~~found for the large pipes~~,
baskets, 8-Fers bucket painted outside red, 10 fertiger buckets (paint inside red.)

Corn hand planter, screen for strain dirt, spray material, Cases of oil,

One barrel of track roller grease, (just about $\frac{1}{4}$ left)

One barrel of standard oil diesel engine crankcase oil (some left)

One barrel of S.A.E. 90 transmission oil, (some left)

Two 55 gal original gasoline barrel, (empty)

One 15 gal oil barrel (empty),

One 5 gal can use for gasoline or oil ~~and~~ for fueling ^{the} tractor,

One large funnel with screen in,

In case no oil left in the barrels, we just need the empty barrels,
except track roller grease barrel,

I wish to ^{take} Krusich garage in Milpitas to look over the car.

We have another Ford two door sedan 1928 blue color (without license) which
has 5 tires. we would like to have the tires with the rims on.

I asked in Grand Junction freight office and they said it is alright to put
the car together with household goods, so I wish to have ^{it} put in the box car.

I asked around here and Grand Junction about the price of 1940 or 1941
used car driven over 25000 miles and they said it cost \$1150⁰⁰ up so I think
it would be cheaper to get our car.

I wrote to Krusich garage in Milpitas to look over one of
my cars 1930 model A Ford (black sedan) so in case they call you
let them take care of ~~the car~~ and when they send you the bill
pay it from my account please. When I left it at home
the engine and the tires were in good condition.
