*The Background for Redress:*

*Last year the Japanese American Citizens League launched a national redress campaign to focus on the ethical, moral and constitutional questions involved in the mass incarceration of Japanese Americans on the West Coast during World War II.*

*Two bills supported by JACL, .R. 5499 and S. 1647, have been filed and are now pending in Congress. The purpose of these bills is "to establish a (Presidential) Commission to gather facts to determine whether any wrong was committed against those American citizens and permanent resident aliens affected by Executive Order Numbered 9066, and for other purposes."*

*This first Regional Forum has been planned to raise the awareness of New England residents to the Congressional bills and to their wider implications for all peoples, particularly in times of international crises.*
