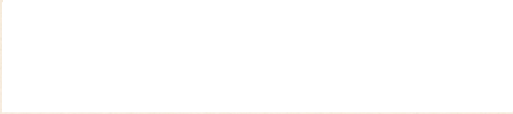


RESUME OF J. DAVID SAKURA
