You said that Norman Hanger is in the Army by now. Well, I think he's coming to our company because we are expecting some fellows from Fort Douglas.

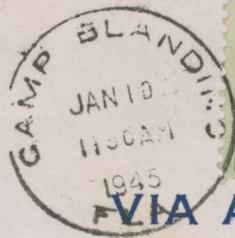
I'm not sure but we might get our furloughs this Thursday or Friday. I don't know but it's only my guess.
