Dear Mom and Pop,

We arrived in camp around 12:30 PM today. I was late 30 minutes but there's so many reporting that when I finished checking in, it was around 2:00 PM. This has the bed below me. We sleep in double bunkers. Boy, the barracks here are swell, and nice. I'm up on the third floor. We have four floors and the building is all brick. All the houses around here are. We also went to a show tonight. We saw "Practically Yours". It was pretty good.

We can go out every night out of camp if we are not on duty. We were going to Washington tonight but changed our minds. It's only a 45 minute bus ride from here. So is Baltimore. We'll go some

other night. We can also get week
end passes so I think Skins and
I will go to New York this week-end
if we can.

We got some equipment today.
Tomorrow, we're going to the warehouse
to get some shoes and some other
clothing.

The show around here are
just like in the city. It's a trials
building with real nice seats.

Don't forget to send stamps.

By the way, we got paid today
for the trip from Blanding to Meade.
I got \$31.42. I'll get paid my
regular \$42.00 at the end of the
month too.

When I came here, I received
a lot of your letters. I haven't
read them yet.

I also received Bob's ³ letter.
He told me what extra things to
bring.

I also have a letter from John
but haven't read it yet. I'll
tell you about it tomorrow.

We stopped in Chicago
about 4 hours so we looked
around and had dinner there.
It's a pretty big town but it's
kind of dirty. When the train first
pulled into ~~into~~ Washington I
saw the capital and the Washington
Monument. Until then I didn't realize
we were there. Then from Washington
we took a bus into camp. It's
only 20 or so miles and takes 45
minutes to get there as I said before.
We are going to have a training

review, so it's not going to be too bad.

Well, I think that's enough for tonight. If there's any thing you want to know or I forget to tell you, let me know.

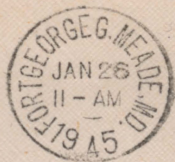
