Dear Mom and Pop

I think today is the 29th Well, I'm in New York. We left Meade on Saturday around 1:30 PM and got here around 5:30 PM. We have until Monday 4:00 AM. Then we have to go back. We went all over tonight. Boy, I never saw anything like it. Full buildings, lots of people, why, it's just like 6:00 PM right now. All the lights are on and lots of people walking around.

We went to the Stage Door Canteen and looked around. We're going to Radio City tomorrow. And by the way, we saw Artie Shaw and his orchestra tonight at the theater. It was very good. I'm staying at the Times Square Hotel. We have a nice room. I'm going to take a bath now and go to sleep. There's lots of things to do yet tomorrow. I don't think I'll have time to write tomorrow or I should say tonight so I'll write to you Monday night when I get back to camp, till then
