Dear Mom and Pop,

I received two of your letters today. One was last Thursday's and the other was Saturday's. I didn't get Friday's. You said you still didn't get my letter yet on Saturday. Well, I hope you got it on Monday. I hope you have my address now.

We got paid today. I got \$43.10. My wallet is fat again.

We went out in the fields today to fire our rifles. We had field firing. We shot a lot of ammunition and had fun, but we had to clean our rifles later. Boy, it sure was cold this morning! There was ice in my canteen this morning when we went out in the fields.

It's warmer tonight. 5 kids and I went to the movies tonight. We saw "The Man's Navy" with Wallace Beery. It was a good typical Beery show. Pretty good!

I want to thank you for the snapshots you sent me. They came out pretty good. Thanks a lot.

I haven't anything planned for the weekend but I might go out to New York again. Now, at least, I know some body there so I'll have something to do.

Well, snuf' for tonight. There's not much doing tonight. I'll write to you again tomorrow
