We didn't do very much today, although we had a interesting class. We learned all about the German soldier and his equipment. There were a couple of men from the German Intelligence School who took charge. They showed the different types of uniform and guns. (all captured). So make it interesting they spoke in German. Later they spoke with that funny German accent, on purpose, so we really amused. They used that heavy German accent so well ~~that~~ they, we laughed till we had tears in our eyes.

We have nite problem tonite so
I'll write more when I come back.

Well, we just came back. I don't
have much time. We had a
6 mile hike. It wasn't bad at all.

Of all the luck, I could
chew my rifle. I got KP on
Sunday! - I can't go out there
so I guess I'll go to Washington
tomorrow.
