I received your Monday's letter. I'm glad to hear you got my letter that day. I also got the stamps. Thanks a lot.

We had classes in land mines in the morning and in the afternoon we went to fire mortars. The only thing was that we didn't have enough time so our group didn't even fire. We're not complaining, heh, heh!

I haven't too much to write about today. I don't know what we're doing tonight so I'll write more later.

7:30 PM

Well, I'm back again. We went to the PX after dinner but when we got there, we found out that it closes every Thursday so we went to the bowling alley

I haven't very much to write about tonight.

Oh, yes, about the food here. I always said the food in Blanding was good but here it's really good! Every day we have something good to eat. We have veal, beef, lamb or pork in turn and all kinds of dessert. Today for dinner we had spanish meat loaf, corn, potatoes, spinach, cinnamon rolls, peaches and oh, yes, hot soup. We have soup every day and after we come in from the cold, the hot soup really taste swell.
