Well, here I am back in Washington again.

I'm with Chester Fukuhera. You remember him. I came to Washington with him last Saturday.

Shiro went to see his brother and I thought he might want to see him alone since this might be the last time we're in Washington. We have a very nice room at this hotel. We were very lucky indeed to get this room. Even the Service Center was filled up and we tried this place just as a chance and we got a room. I know we were pretty lucky because we tried other places the last time I came here with Shiro. You remember me telling you about it.

We had a very nice day today. It was the first time since we came here that it was so warm. We didn't need overcoats or even heavy underwear.

I sent (I already told you, I think) a lot of stuff home today and

You should be getting them soon. I
sent one hand bag and one box.
There's cigarettes for Jo-cha. I'm sorry
I couldn't get the kind he smokes but
they just didn't have any. I tried
to get Chesterfields too, but they didn't

smoke I didn't send you anything. I
hope you don't mind. I have some dirty
underwear in the bag so just wash them
and keep them for me.

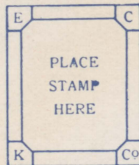
Dear

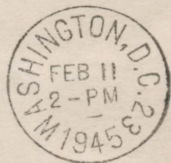
