Dear Mom and Pop,

Well, I'm back in camp again. Chester and I spent the day sight seeing. We planned to see all the different things and buildings in Washington but when we went to the Smithsonian Institution, we stayed there all day. I think you've heard of the Smithsonian. It's one of the biggest and best museums. It's actually divided into about 4 buildings. We saw first the different things of manufacture such as lumber, synthetic articles, plastics, steel, glass, etc. Then we went to see the different kinds of weapons and then airplanes and then the different kinds of human races. Later we went to see the different stuffed animals. By the time we saw everything, it was around 4:30 so we went up to the business district ~~of~~ again. We had dinner there and then we

went to a show. After we came
out of the show, we had a coke
and then went to the bus depot
to go back to camp. There were several
cabs there and they said that they
would take us back to camp for \$2.00
apiece so we took a cab instead.
Since it's so far and the buses were
crowded we thought it best.

We're going to have a clothing inspection
tomorrow.

I haven't received your letters cause
I've been out so I'll get them tomorrow.

I'll keep writing as long as I can.
I don't know whether we're going
Tuesday but if you don't hear that
means I went to New York so don't
worry. I sent a card (change of address)
to you and Joni so don't be too
stoked.
