Well, it's still early and I don't have much to write.

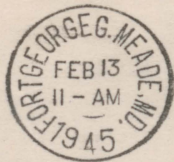
I hope you're not worrying too much because I can imagine how you feel.

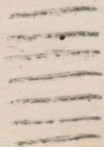
