We had clothing inspection and such today, but all in all, we're not too busy.

It's still snowing on and off but it isn't as cold so you'd think it would be.

I bought some stuff to take over seas this morning, like soap, tooth paste and things like that.

There isn't very much to write about because we don't do very much.

I bought a ring but it's not the kind I was planning to get. They didn't have the gold ones so I got a sterling silver ring. If I see the gold one, I'm going to get it.

I thought I could get a

cigarette lighter for Pop here but
I haven't seen any at the P.X. I
still might find one yet.
