I haven't received your letters yet because I moved here but I know they're waiting for me.

I forgot when To-chan is going to California. Maybe he'll be on his way when this letter reaches you. If he is, tell him to take care of him self and not to worry about me. I hope Hana is getting along O.K. She's probably getting fat, isn't she?

I had a nice dinner tonight - steak with string beans, potatoes, salad, cake and coffee.

I can't help laughing right now cause I'm listening to Danny Kaye on the radio. He sure is funny.

Dear Mom and Pop,

How's things going? I'm feeling fine. I've been reading magazines all morning. Just had a glass of pineapple juice. I have no fever and the throat is much better. I'm going over to the P.O. later on to get the Sunday papers.

The weather these past few days has been very good. The sun is shining and very thing looks nice outside. I don't know how cold it is because I haven't been out yet.

If Pop has left on his trip when this letter reaches you, I hope you call Kuri-san or some of your friends over or go see them yourself. I don't like you to stay home by yourself.

Gee, I bet Bob would turn green with envy if he saw me ~~there~~ now. Have you heard from him?

You know, I don't know a single thing
about what's happening back home cause
I haven't received your letters yet. I hope
I get them soon. I think it's in camp
already but I guess my company is hold-
ing it for me till I get back. I'll
have plenty to read later so it's O.K.

Did you get the packages it sent
home from Meade? Shine my shoes and
put them away for me, will you?

Well, I just learned they're
kicking me out of the hospital.
I'll be back at my company
this afternoon.

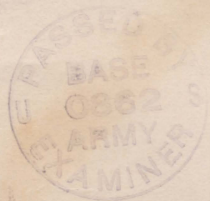
