Dear Mom and Pop,

No fever today. I went for breakfast this morning and had cereal, boiled eggs, ~~toast~~ toast, jelly roll, and milk. I've been reading magazines and listening to the radio all morning. I'm afraid this is too good to last long.

One thing I don't like is that we have to take pills about every 4 hours. Gee, they woke me up 11:30 PM and 4:30 AM just to give me pills. Then I have to gargle my throat with salt water tea. It's still early and I don't have much to write, so I'll write more later.

3:30 PM

We had various kinds of exams this afternoon, had our eyes, teeth and ears tested and also had our blood tested.

I'm feeling fine today, no fever and my throat is just a little sore. I bought some magazines at the PX today and I'm reading them now.

Had a walk times at noon.

We had roast beef. Since I'm OK
and don't have any fever, I go to mess.
The first night I came I had fever so they
brought a food tray for me. Now that I'm
OK I gotta go get my food. Darn it!

You know, I'm getting so lousy the
only one I wrote to is you. I sent John
and Ted my address and Tomi too, but
I didn't write letters. You better say hello
to Tomi for me. I don't think I'll write to
John yet cause I imagine he couldn't answer
yet anyway.

I don't think it's wise to write to
Grandpa for awhile. You know why, I guess.
Please tell Po-chan to write to him for me.
Tell him I'm OK but don't tell him I'm
in the hospital cause he worries over nothing.
I hope you're not worrying.

I'll write again tomorrow.

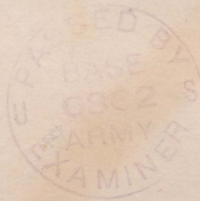
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
