Dear Mom and Pop,

I just came back from chow. Boy, am I full. We had hamburgers tonite.

I guess Jo-chan is back by now. How did he like the trip? How did Mr. Schemp look? I hope he had a nice tripe.

I received your first letter that was addressed here. It was written on the 17<sup>th</sup>. I'm glad you have the new address now.

You asked how I wanted my socks, long or short. Well, if you going to knit them, make them short. I don't know how they wear it overseas but from what I hear from Bob, they fold their socks over their feet. We don't do that. We tuck our pants over the socks and blouse the pants a little over our feet. If I need long socks, I'll write to you for some.

I didn't receive the money yet but I guess I'll get it tomorrow or so. I hope you wired it.

We didn't do much today. We were going on a hike in the morning but it

was raining so we stayed in our  
barracks. In the afternoon, we all  
went to the gym and played basket ball  
and things like that.

I bought some ice cream.

I think I'll jump into bed early tonight  
and read a bit. We're going to a movie  
tomorrow afternoon. Pretty good, eh?
