Dear Mom and Pop,

We didn't do very much this morning. We sent our clothes to the cleaners and got them back today.

That telegram didn't seem to come yet. I hope it gets here soon.

We all went to the movies this afternoon. We saw "A Tree Grows in Brooklyn". It was a very good movie. Did you see it yet?

We're going on a night march tonight. We'll be out 3 hours. I don't know how far you will walk but I don't think it'll be too far.

The lieutenant told us about school studies during our spare time. I could take a college extension course from the Utah State Ag school. It's sort of a correspondence course. The government pays half of the expense. I'm thinking of taking bacteriology but I think I'll wait awhile. If I go overseas and don't have enough time, there's no use taking the course, so I'll just

wait and see how it comes out. I think  
that's O.K., isn't it?

I'll write more after I get back from  
the hike.
