Dear Mom and Pop,

I finished guard around 1:00 PM today. I just had to walk around four times so it wasn't too fast.

After guard, I went to the movies with Chester. The whole company went. We saw "A Song to Remember". It was a very good picture. Did it come to Salt Lake yet?

My letters these days are pretty short because I don't do much.

I didn't get that telegram yet, but I know it's here. The lieutenant is pretty busy and so he didn't get it yet. There's around 6 other boys who's waiting too. I think we'll get it tomorrow because we asked him already. We're going to be paid on Wednesday so I'll have plenty again.

I haven't received your letters yet but I know it'll reach me sooner or later so I'm not worried. I only hope you're getting my letters regularly.

The weather is getting gradually better.
It still freezes in the morning but during
the middle of the day it's just right and
everything starts to melt so our shoes and
over shoes get muddy.

I'm going to bed early tonight and read
a bit.
