Then he said, "well I guess \$15 is mine because you got \$40." Boy, was I pleased. Thanks very much. It's just in time. You see, we can get passes from now on. We can go out from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM. I'm going to New York tomorrow. - I hope!

I'm going to the movies tonite. I'll write home when I get back.

9:30 PM

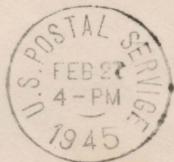
I just took a shower. We went to the movies tonight. We enjoyed it very much.
