Dear Mom and Pop,

Well, I just got paid today. I received \$43.60 so my wallet is fat again.

We had a swell time in New York last night. We first went to eat at a Chinese cafe. Boy, we sure ate a lot. After dinner we walked around looking at stores and theaters. We finally ended up at a stage show. Johnnie Long's orchestra was playing and I wanted to hear it so we went in. Just lucky, they had a movie preview that night. We saw "Bring on the Girls." We thought they were going to show just a part of it, but they showed the whole movie so we really enjoyed it.

We came out at 12:00 PM and found everything closed. You know, stores and such close after 12:00 o'clock from now on. We went to a cafeteria for a bite to eat and then we took a bus home.

They're going to issue passes from noon tomorrow so if I can get a pass "the gang" and I are going out again to New York.

The weather today was cold but the sun was out so it was O.K. I'm always bundled up in heavy underwear, jacket, sweater and field jacket and a wool hood so I'm pretty warm.

We didn't do a thing today. Just loafed around.

We don't plan to go anywhere tonight except maybe to the PX and show.

The mail is coming in pretty regularly now so I'll be hearing from you. I didn't get a letter today but I guess I'll get one or two tomorrow.

This is about all tonight, so I'll write to you again tomorrow.
