Dear Mom and Pop,

I received Monday, Feb 26's letter today. Boy, we had fun yesterday! We first had dinner when we reached New York. After a big dinner, we walked around a bit. We went to Radio City, R.C.A. Building to see radio programs, television, and then to the Empire State Building. We went all the way up to the 102nd floor. When we looked down, we really felt funny. All the cars look like little bugs moving around. After that we walked around Broadway and window shopped. We went into all the big department stores and fattered the sales girls. When we finished looking around, it was late, so we went down to Chinatown and had dinner. After that we went to a stage show and movie. The movie was "A Picture of Donna Gray" and the stage was Xavier Cugat and his orchestra and also Robert Walker, the movie star and also Lena Horne, the big Negro actress. I think you know who I mean.

We came home around 2:00 AM this morning.

Today, I worked at the warehouse. We loaded trucks with stuff to bring to the mess halls. It was pretty easy because we'd ~~making~~ make a trip and then rest about a hour. Anyway, I get out of a hike. Our company went on a hike today and I didn't have to go.

You seemed pretty worried about the wire you sent me. By now, you should know that I received the money so I hope it's O.K.

I just went to the PX tonight. After I come back, I did my laundry and took a shower. After this letter I'm going to bed and read a bit.

This is about all for today so I'll write more tomorrow.
