Everything seemed to be settled. I'm still not attached so I haven't my regular APO number. I'm still with all my friends from Blandine. We may be ~~be~~ split up soon.

We didn't have time to see any of the French towns which we were in France.

Right now Italy is very pretty.

As I was saying, Italy is pretty
right now because everything is
beginning to blossom. It's green everywhere
you look and flowers are growing here
and there. There are quite a few Cherry
trees too. The blossoms look nice

I haven't met Bob or John yet but
maybe I'll see them later.

I haven't received any of your letters
yet but I'm expecting them soon.

Our camp here is pretty good. We
sleep in big tents with eight guys in
each. I'm sleeping with some of my
friends. Steve is two tents away and
Chester is about four tents down.

Well, we did it again. We're restricted with measles again. Gee, oh boy, measles must love us!

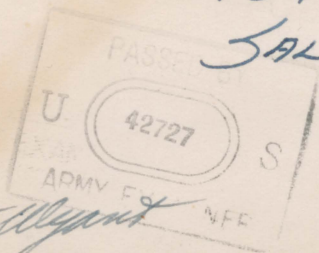
Well, I'll write again tomorrow
