March 30, 1945

Dear Mom and Pop,

I'm just loafing around today. I haven't pulled any detail yet so I'm lucky.

There isn't so much to write about because we don't do a thing all day.

It's very warm during the afternoons so most of the boys play ball or read.

We went to the PX yesterday and bought two weeks ration. We go only once during two weeks and all the items are rationed. I'm stocked up on candy now.

I wrote some letters today because I had nothing to do.

We had a talk from the officers yesterday and one officer said that soon the parents who have sons in the Armed Forces may take citizenship papers out. Of course, it has to go thru Congress yet, but the bill seems pretty strong. Most of the original combat team did make a good

reputation, you know, and this is going
to help it.

The mail hasn't caught up yet so
I'm still waiting.

This is about all for today, so
more tomorrow,

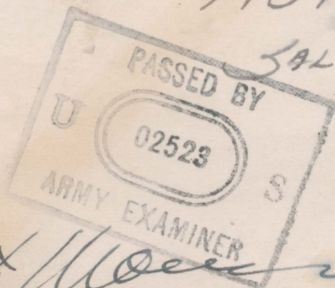
